## **About Honouring Traditions & Reconciliation**

The Honouring Traditions and Reconciliation Pow Wow + Artisan Expo is held annually in September. This is to recognize the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation month on the Traditional Territory of the *Niitsitapi* (Blackfoot-speaking real people), *Siksikaititapi* (Blackfoot Confederacy). What many now call this place Lethbridge, Alberta, is also known as being within Treaty #7 and to the Metis Nation of Alberta as Foothills Metis District 1 – Battle River Territory.

Honouring Traditions and Reconciliation Society is a grassroots, action-based organization that works to bridge gaps in Reconciliation. Participants from any background and experience are welcome to participate in customized educational experiences to promote cultural awareness, appreciation and respect for Indigenous Peoples' histories, contributions, and perspectives. Topics include Indigenous perspectives on land use, how to be an ally, and traditional dance through community-led and collaborative engagement with local Nations and Elders, Language speakers and Knowledge Holders.
